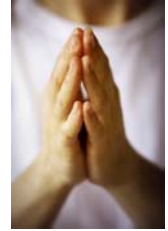

CWF needs to collect 300 more labels from Best Choice products before December 1st to be able to be reimbursed \$60.00.

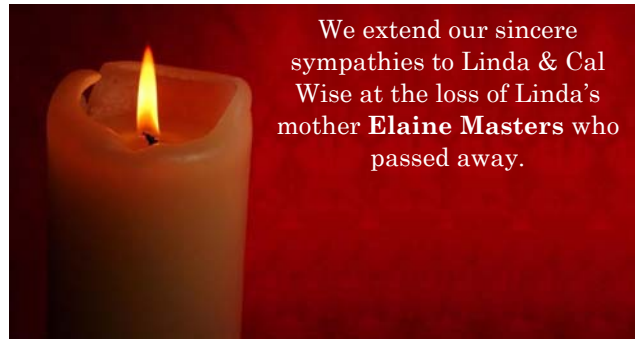


***Please help!***
