

#### Thoughts from the congregation

I recently finished a book by Dr. Richard Haass, president of the nonpartisan Council on Foreign Relations. The premise of Dr. Haass' book is that along with rights, particularly those granted by our Constitution, should come certain responsibilities/obligations. I will tell you, it is, well was not, an "easy read" for me. I frequently found myself rereading paragraphs attempting to digest and discern the meaning and content. So what? What, if anything, does this have to do with Christianity, or with being a Christian?

Well, I got to thinking about something a former minister of mine once said, "Being a Christian is not a spectator sport." Implying being a follower of Christ requires more than sitting on the sidelines. Being a Christian requires active participation.

Being a Christian is not a "once done and done" event that is finalized by one's confession of faith and baptism. If you like, one can liken it a serviceman's or servicewoman's oath of enlistment. With their oath servicepersons receive certain rights/privileges plus numerous responsibilities/obligations. The same is true with a confessed Christian. When one steps forward and states, "I believe Jesus Christ is the Son of the Living God, and I accept Him and my Lord and Savior" he or she is taking an oath, making a promise before witnesses and God that they will follow God's and Christ's commandments. With that promise they are accepting Christ's promise of eternal life. "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life." (John 3:16, NIV) Also written in the Gospel of John is Jesus saying, "For my Father's will is that everyone who looks to the Son and Believes in Him shall have eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day." (John 6:40, NIV) It is recorded of Jesus saying to Lazarus' sister, Martha, "Did I not tell you that if you believe, you would see the glory of God?" (John 11:40, NIV).

So, in accepting the "right," through God's grace, to eternal life what are the obligations that accompany the title of Christian? "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength." (Deu 6:5, NIV) "...Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: Love your neighbor as yourself." (Matt 22:37b-39, NIV) Jesus further said, "All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments." (Matt 22:40, NIV) What does "love the Lord your God and love your neighbor as yourself" look like? Maybe, just maybe it looks like this, "For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me." (Matt 25:35-36, NIV)

Many of us have grown up being taught by our parents to, "Do unto others as you would want them to do to you." Or something akin to that. Well, Jesus first said it, "So in everything, do to others what you would have them do to you, for this sums up the Law and the Prophets." (Matt 7:12, NIV) Our Christian obligations in a nutshell.

In pledging to accept God's grace of life in His presence through eternity (our "Bill of Rights as defined in the Bible), we also commit to the "obligation" to "do to others what you would have them do to you."
