In the Community



Our next opportunity to help out those in our community who are in need of a little food will be on Tuesday, February 20th.

Just like every month, Central Christian Church will be able to help out our neighbors who are in a need of a little assistance. On February 20th we will be preparing food and taking it to Grace United Methodist Church to serve to those in our community who are in need of food and shelter. Because of the cold weather that has been around us for the last month, the number of those coming to get food and shelter has risen. When the temperature drops below freezing the Crisis Cold Weather Shelters open and the only way get a spot in the shelters is signing up at the feedings. That means there are more people than there usually are. In January, Central Christian fed 272 people on our Tuesday, and since then the number of people have gone up. Because of that, we are going to prepare to serve 300 people, just in case the weather is below freezing on that day. If you can help with food donations, volunteering to prepare, transport, or serve the food we would greatly appreciate all help given. There is a sign-up sheet on the desk outside of the church office with the needs for the upcoming meal. Thank you for all your support and everything that each one of you do for Central Christian, the community of Springfield, and all God's children.
